CANYONS SKIER/RIDER RESPONSIBILITY CODE	
1.	Always stay in control and avoid excessive speed. You must be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
2.	People ahead of you have the right-of-way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
3.	Do not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
4.	Before starting downhill or merging onto a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
5.	If you are involved in an accident or collision, you must exchange contact information with the other party.
6.	Always use proper devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
7.	Observe and obey all posted signs and warnings.
8.	Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
9.	You must have sufficient physical dexterity, ability and knowledge to safely load, ride and unload lifts.
10.	You may not ski or snowboard at Canyons if you are impaired by drugs or alcohol.

### GUEST SERVICES (36)

Guest Services is located in the Resort Village near the base terminal of the Red Pine Gondola. You will also find a Guest Services facility located mid-mountain adjacent to Red Pine Lodge. ### ATMS AND LOCKERS (27)

### FREE CITY BUS SERVICE

Park City's free bus service can be accessed at the Transit Center, which is located at the bottom of the Cabrioleet lift, adjacent to Base Camp. ## BE SAFE OUT THERE

FIRST AID  
 An on-site clinic is located in the base area. First aid facilities are available at the top of many lifts as indicated on the map. If you come across an accident, cross a pair of skis or place a snowboard in the snow uphill of the scene to warn other skiers and to help Ski Patrol locate the accident. Do not move the injured person unless absolutely necessary. Notify a patroller, have someone call for patrol or contact a lift attendant at the base of any lift and have them contact patrol. HELMETS  
 Canyons encourages its skiers and riders to educate themselves about the benefits and limitations of winter sports helmets. For information on helmet safety go to www.nsa.org.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES  
 Canyons discourages the use of electronic devices - cell phones, earphones or music players - while skiing or riding.

SLOW ZONES  
 Certain areas (indicated on the map in yellow) are designated as SLOW ZONES. Please observe the posted slow areas by maintaining a speed no faster than the general flow of traffic. Space and speed are especially important in these areas. Fast and aggressive skiing and riding will not be tolerated.

NOTICE OF INHERENT RISK AND ASSUMPTION OF RISKS  
 Under Utah law, a skier/ rider assumes the risk of any injury to person or property resulting from any of the inherent dangers and risks of skiing/riding and may not recover from any ski area operator for any injury resulting from any of the inherent dangers and risks of skiing, including: changing weather conditions; existing and changing snow conditions; bare spots, rocks, stumps, trees; collisions with natural objects, man-made objects, or other skiers/riders; variations in terrain; the failure of skiers/riders to ski/ride within their own abilities; cliffs, extreme terrain, jumps; and freestyle terrain. **CAUTION: Snowcats, snowmobiles and snowmaking may be encountered at any time.**
