## SKI AREA & STATISTICS

**Mountain Range** - Steamboat is a complete mountain range: Mount Werner, Sunshine Peak, Storm Peak, Thunderhead Peak, Pioneer Ridge, and Christie Peak. 2,965 acres (1200 hectares) of permitted terrain offer a diversity of trails for all levels of ability. Gladed areas of Pioneer Ridge, Sunshine and Storm Peak are Steamboat's particular claim to fame, with legendary Champagne Powder® snow in the trees for the most avid powder hounds.

**Location** - Steamboat, located in northwest Colorado, 160 miles/267kms northwest of Denver, is an easy three-hour drive from Denver. Take I-70 west through the Eisenhower Tunnel to the Silverthorne exit (#205), then go north on Colorado Highway 9 to the town of Kremmling, then west on US 40 over Rabbit Ears Pass. Steamboat is accessible by nonstop air service from sixteen major U.S. airports on American, Alaska, Delta, JetBlue, Southwest, and United Airlines in addition to connecting service from hundreds of domestic and international cities.

### Transforming The Experience

While Steamboat has been shaped by its rich past, today, with this project's completion, we look forward to shaping the future. Our parent company, Alterra, has invested over \$200 million on and around our mountain, so we can enhance the Steamboat experience for everyone who visits us. This unprecedented venture will help to make us one of the premier ski destinations in the world for decades to come. This was an ambitious undertaking; the likes of which our resort has never seen. Our plans came to life, with an après ski plaza, new restaurants and bars, a new stage, and an ice rink. On the Mountain - new lifts and new terrain has made us the second largest resort in Colorado. In the tradition of our pioneering spirit and out of the genuine western heritage of Steamboat, comes an entirely new vision for our resort. Welcome to the new west.

### DOING GOOD. It's In Our Nature.

Throughout the construction process, we are focused on four critical strategies to be as green and sustainable as possible.

- **Waste Reduction:** During demolition, all steel and concrete materials were recycled for a 70% diversion of demolition waste. During construction, we are choosing building materials that contain a high level of recycled content.
- **Energy Efficiency:** In our new base area buildings, we are taking steps to be as efficient with energy and water as possible. We can even monitor our energy and water use in real time, allowing us to adjust operations to conserve energy and water throughout the day.
- **Guest Education:** At every opportunity, we will educate guests and staff about the resort sustainability efforts and how they can take action to preserve our environment.
- **LEED Certification:** All base area buildings will be LEED-certified, a rigorous government review process. Not only will these buildings use less energy, but they will also be healthier for our staff and our guests



## On Mountain Improvements

### A Top-to-Bottom Gondola

The new Wild Blue Gondola is longest and fastest 10-person gondola in North America. With the lower leg opening in winter 22/23, and the upper leg opening in 23/24, the state-of-the-art gondola will feed skiers/riders through a newly created mid-station adjacent to Bashor bowl with the final destination at the top of Sunshine Peak. At a total length of 3.16 miles, the new gondola will increase the out of base capacity from 6,000 people per hour to 10,000 people per hour, getting skiers from bottom to top in 13 minutes.

### Learning Center for All

The recently re-graded Rough Rider/Bashor Basin area is now the home to the Greenhorn Ranch, an area that will be dedicated to beginner skiers and riders. Featuring a slope graded for beginners that will be a 0% to 15% angle, and progressive Terrain-Based Learning developed with Snow Operating and a dedicated chairlift. The lower leg of the Wild Blue Gondola will have an unloading option at Greenhorn Ranch, making access to beginner terrain easy for those new to skiing and riding.

### Mahogany Ridge

650 additional of expert/advanced acreage has made Steamboat the 2nd largest ski resort in Colorado (from the 5th largest). This adventurous, gladed terrain opened in winter 23/24 and is serviced from a new chairlift. Steamboat has long been known for our pristine intermediate terrain, and this new expansion will put us on the map for the best skiers and snowboarders in the world.

### Enhanced Snowmaking

In order to provide an improved experience in Greenhorn Ranch and on Sunshine Peak, we need to make sure the surface is consistently covered and can open early. That's where our new automated, Low-E snowmaking technology comes in – ensuring our most popular terrain is available by peak holiday visitation. First Tracks fans will rejoice with earlier season coverage and new skiers will embrace the top tier grooming and snowmaking efforts just for them.

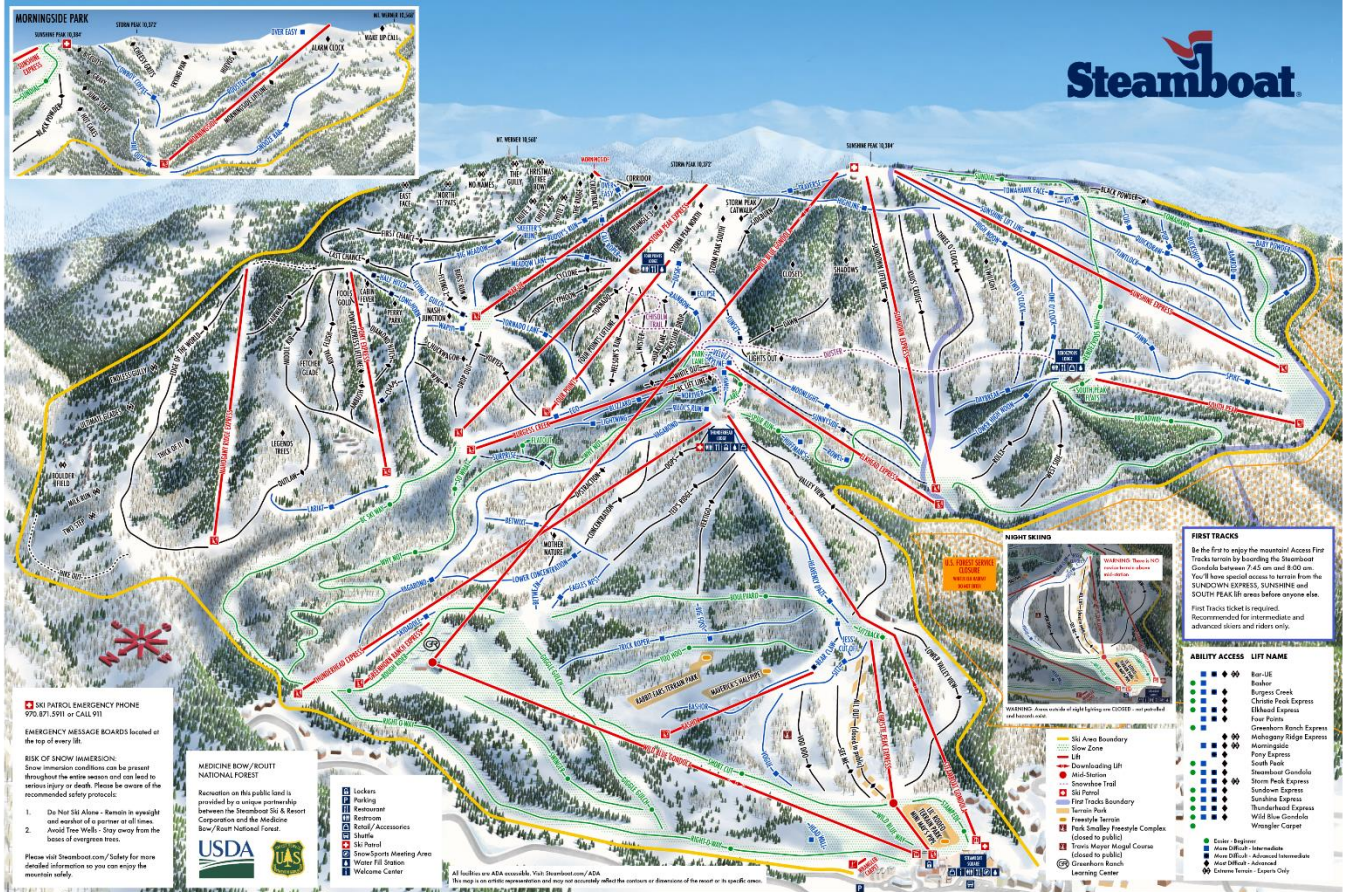

# STEAMBOAT WINTER BASE AREA MAP



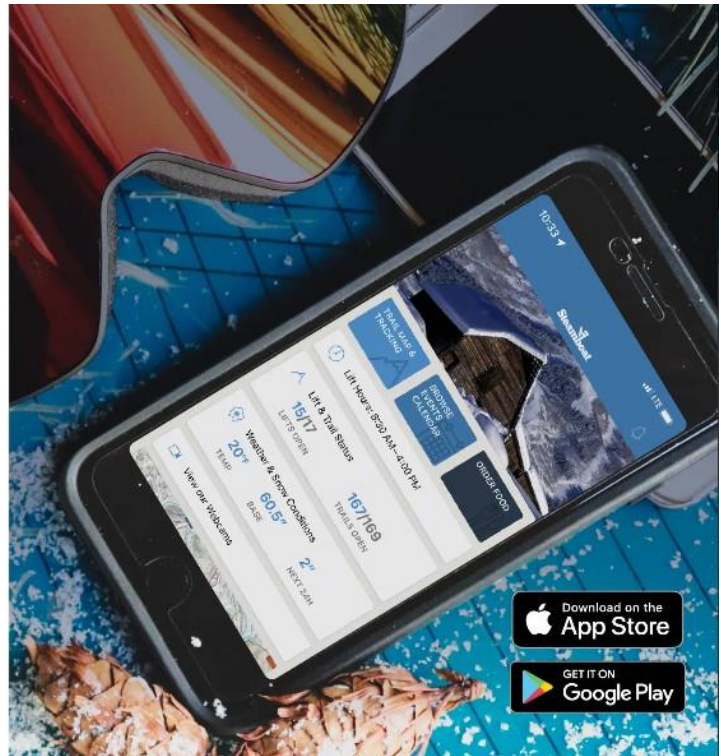

\***Stoker Bar & Restaurant**- Located inside Thunderhead Lodge at the top of the Steamboat Gondola, Stoker offers a comprehensive range of beers, wines, soft drinks, and delicious food. \***Western BBQ**- Don't forget your cowboy hat for this wild, family-friendly ride. Load up in the gondola and head up to the top of Thunderhead Lodge. \***Rendezvous Food Court**- The Rendezvous Saddle is conveniently located halfway down High Noon, perfect for staying on the "sunny side" of the mountain and enjoying a tasty lunch. With Asian specialties, burgers, pizza, salads, and soups, Rendezvous Saddle has something to offer for everyone. And if you are looking for a place to enjoy a cold beverage, our Umbrella Bar is located on the deck—perfect for taking in the beautiful views of the surrounding mountains.

Steamboat is more than just skiing and riding. Immerse yourself in western heritage with horseback rides, snowmobiling, hot springs, sleigh ride dinners, winter photography tours, and more. Whether summer or winter, there's no shortage of activities available for those looking to experience the playground wonderland that is Steamboat Springs, Colorado.

**Scenic Gondola Rides** - Take a ride up Mt. Werner and enjoy the views that can only be appreciated from the Steamboat Gondola. Note: Receive one Kids Ride Free ticket for a child ages 5-12 years with purchase of an adult (13+ years) Ticket. Limit one free Kids Ride Free ticket per adult (ages 13 & up) ticket. Guests who have purchased a 23/24 Ikon Pass, 23/24 Ikon Base Pass, or 23/24 Ikon Base Plus Pass receive unlimited Scenic Gondola Rides. Simply go to the ticket office, located inside the Steamboat Sports Sheraton location, to receive your Scenic Gondola Ride ticket.

**Cross Country Skiing** - **The Haymaker Nordic Center** has 10km of groomed trails for Classic skiing, Skate skiing and Snowshoeing - all ability levels welcome! A Trail Access Ticket is required, and multi-day tickets are available. The Haymaker Nordic Center offers Classic ski group lessons and rental equipment for all ages and abilities. Rental equipment is available on site; a Nordic ski expert will fit your equipment from head to toe. Lessons are offered daily for Classic and Skate skiing.

**Skeeter's Ice Rink** - Skeeter's Ice Rink takes centerstage in Steamboat Square. The rink is free to the public with their own skates. Skate rentals, both hockey and figure skates, are available for a fee for adults and children, first come, first serve. Guests must be wearing skates to enter the rink.

**Snowshoeing** - Steamboat Resort has dedicated snowshoe trails on-mountain and offers snowshoe rentals at our Steamboat Sports - Steamboat Square locations that can be purchased in person on a first come, first serve basis.

**Photography Tours** - Winter photography tours offer unique photo opportunities guided by a professional photographer who will help you to develop an eye for composition, use of light, and how to tell a visual story of your photography adventure. Tours are geared towards all abilities from beginners to advanced, with phone cameras to DSLR's. 1 - 3 people per tour.

**Crooked Key Escape Room** - Located in downtown Steamboat; owned and run by locals. Play one of four top-rated escape rooms! Find clues, solve puzzles, and have fun. Indoor or outdoor options available. Family-friendly and highly rated and recommended.

**Bowling** - **Snowbowl** has been a staple of the Steamboat Springs community for the last 50 years. Built in 1977 and reimagined in 2019, it is the only family bowling center in Routt County. Featuring 12 AMF lanes, arcade games, the largest screen in Steamboat, and an award-winning restaurant and bar. Our 8,000 square foot turf hosts live concerts, movies, events and games, and is dog friendly!

**Steamboat Snowmobile Tours** - Discover the magic of snowmobiling Colorado's Continental Divide on Rabbit Ears Pass. The extensive trail system is a snowmobiler's dream. Located in the middle of the Routt National Forest, with views extending to Wyoming your ride will take you through tree lined trails and to big open meadows where your guide will give you free time to play around. These tours are available for all ability levels. Drivers must be at least 16 years old. Drivers with passenger must be at least 18 years old. Minimum age is 3 years old.

**Hot Air Ballooning** - **Wild West Balloon Adventures** stunning views of the Steamboat Springs area, the Flat Top Mountains, and an inactive Volcano to the North, called Hahn's Peak. Our early morning flights include a champagne ceremony after the flight and a personalized flight certificate.

**Hot Springs**- Celebrate Steamboat with a soak in one of the historic hot springs.

**Old Town Hot Springs**- Located in downtown, Old Town Hot Springs offers hot springs-fed pools, two waterslides, a climbing wall, and a fitness center. The swimming and soaking pools of Old Town Hot Springs served as a gathering and bathing place for the Ute Indians who first settled in the area. In the late 1800s, it was a social spot for the early homesteaders. Today, the family-friendly facility is the place for recreation and rejuvenation for visitors and locals alike. Kids will love the waterslides and rock-climbing wall. A kiddie pool, lap pool, fitness center and adults-only spring make this the perfect family destination.

**Strawberry Hot Springs**- Nestled in an aspen grove in the mountains about 15 minutes from downtown Steamboat, the wilderness setting highlights the rustic beauty of the Yampa Valley. Several hot pools of varying temperatures are fed by the natural spring water and the rushing Hot Spring Creek. Access Strawberry Park Hot Springs by a short drive. Four-wheel drive is recommended for the rugged but beautiful drive there. Or take an all-inclusive shuttle service that will take care of everything for you.

**Saddleback Ranch** -Wayne and Luanna Lacovetto purchased Saddleback Ranch from Luanna's father, Jim Thompson, in 1993. In the years prior to ranching, they had other family-owned and operated businesses, including a cattle feedlot, a fishing store, and a grocery store. Today, the working cattle ranch and recreational business of Saddleback Ranch is a product of their combined visions and a lifetime of experiences. They take great pride in the ranch and their way of life, but most of all they love sharing it with the thousands of people who come to visit every year.

**Winter Horseback Rides**- Join us on an hour and a half to two-hour horseback ride (weather permitting) over the hills and through the trees of snowy Saddleback Ranch. Gaze at the Flattops, Sleeping Giant, and Mt. Werner. Let us show you where our ancestors homesteaded the ranch almost 100 years ago. After your Steamboat Springs horseback ride, warm up with a cup of hot chocolate and a freshly baked cookie. We have horses for all riding abilities.

**YEE-HAW Snow Tubing**- Strap on your spurs, pull down your hat, and ride Saddleback Ranch's tubing hill. Located just 15 miles west of Steamboat Springs, YEE-HAW HILL is sure to be the highlight of your vacation. The hill is groomed and equipped with a state-of-the-art tube-tow lift system that attaches itself to the tube to transport you back to the top. From there, speed down one of the three runs on the hill on a large inner tube provided by the ranch. At the bottom, warm up in our warming lodge, grab a bite to eat, a warm drink, and hit the slope again. Snow tubing is fun winter recreation that's suitable for kids and adults of all ages, and children four and under are free but must ride with an adult.

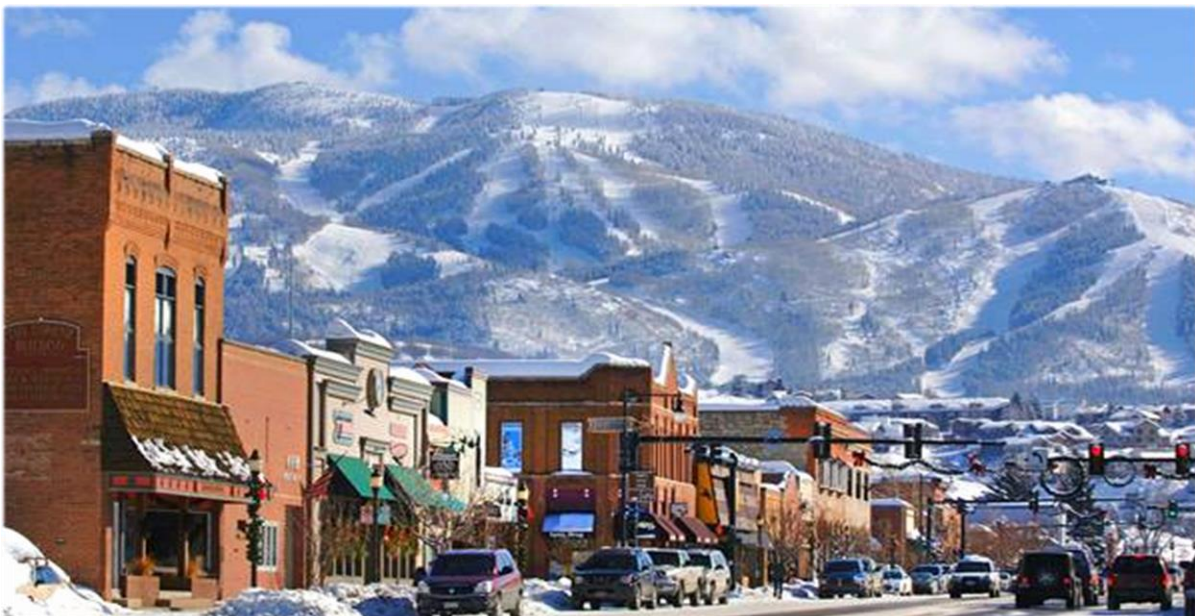

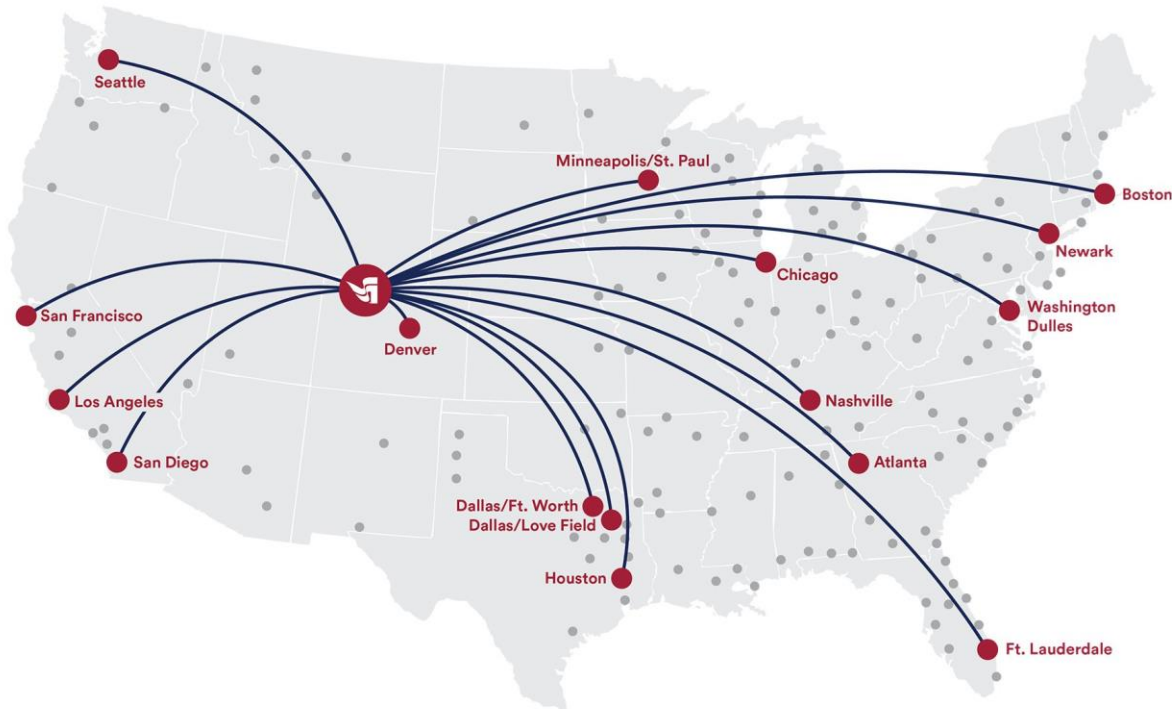

Yampa Valley Regional Airport is a small airport and does not offer the same amenities that larger, international airports may. Guests need to have confirmed ground transportation reservations before arriving as onsite availability is usually not obtainable. There are limited independent shuttles and rental cars, which require advanced reservations, and Uber/Lyft are not consistently available. Please plan accordingly.

### Flights to Denver

Located 170 miles from Steamboat Springs. Over 400 daily flights are offered into Denver International Airport (DEN) from over 200 destinations on 23 airlines. Driving from Denver takes approximately 4 hours on most days, weather dependent. The scenic drive is breathtaking! You can get a rental car or take a shuttle from either airport to Steamboat.

## Airport Shuttle

**Steamboat Express** - Our team of professional drivers will whisk you to and from Denver or Hayden airports with door to door service to your destination. We offer shared and private rides. **Steamboat Express shuttle reservations must be made 4 days in advance.**
